I.- FIELD DAYS

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Field Days consists of two separate competitions:

There is an individual 18 hole stroke play competition and

a two-man best ball competition.

- C. Play will be from the white tees.
- D. Current handicap index at the day of play will be used. (See Current Handicap Index)
- E. A player must complete 18 holes, on the day of play, to be eligible for any prize.

1.Individual Competition

a. Individual competition includes gross score, net score, long drive (L.D.), and closest to the pin (K.P.) competitions.

Divisions in the individual competitions shall be as follows:

First Division: 0-11 handicap indexes

Second Division: 12-16 handicap indexes

Third Division: 17-21 handicap indexes

Fourth Division: 22+ handicap indexes

b. Entry into the individual competition is \$10.00 per player.

2.Best Ball Competition

- a. A player must be entered in the individual competition to enter the best ball competition.
- b. Players may enter the Two-Man Best Ball competition as many times as they choose with as many different partners as desired.
 A 15 stroke maximum handicap index differential will be allowed between partners. (See General Rules)
- c. Entry into the two-man best ball competition is \$4.00 per each two man team.

II.- MEDAL PLAY TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play will be gross and net.
- C. The full recent handicap index will be used (See Current Handicap Index).
- D. Divisions will be determined by number of entries and ages (for senior events). A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions.

III.- SCRAMBLE TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play will be team gross and net scores.
- C. Handicap will be the team total handicap divided by the number of players, taken from team gross score.
- D. Divisions will be determined by number of entries, team handicaps, and ages (for senior events).
- E. A minimum of 2 drives and 2 second shots, each nine, will be used.
- F. Through the green the ball may be placed within one club length of the shot used but must remain in the same cut of grass. 6" is to be used on the putting green. In a bunker, the bunker may be raked between players shots.
- G. Once the ball is holed, the team is deemed to have finished the hole.

IV.- Y-W-B TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play will be gross and net. Holes will be played from different tees, yellow, white, or blue as designated by the Tournament Committee. (Example: Holes 2,5,7,12,14,16 played from the yellow tee markers; Holes: 3,6,8,11,15,17 played from the white markers; Holes 1,4,9,10,13,18 played from the blue markers.)
- C. Full Handicaps will be used, based from the white tees, and taken from the gross score. (See Current Handicap Index)
- D. Divisions will be determined by number of entries and ages (for senior events). A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions.

V.- BEST BALL TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play will be gross & net scores by division. Best score of team player will be chosen.
- C. Full individual handicaps will be used, strokes where they fall. (See Current Handicap Index)
- D. Divisions may be determined by number of entries and ages (for senior events). A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions.

VI.- 1-2-3 TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play will be up to four man teams with total net scores, varied for each three holes: 1st hole, one net score; 2nd hole, two net scores; 3rd hole, three net scores; 4th hole, one net score. Scoring will continue as such for the 18 holes of competition.
- C. Full individual handicaps (See Current Handicap Index) will be used, strokes where they fall.
- D. Teams to be determined by Tournament Chairman for either blind draw or by individual team sign ups.

VII.- MODIFIED STABLEFORD TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Total point scores will be based on net stroke scores. Highest point totals will win. Full individual handicaps will be used, strokes where they fall. Points scored will be:
 - a. >Bogey 0 pts
 b. Bogey 1 pt
 c. Par 2 pts
 d. Birdie 3 pts
 e. Eagle 4 pts
 f. Dbl Eagle 5 pts
- C. For individual play, divisions may be determined by number of entries and ages (for senior events). A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions.
- D. Optional games will be two man teams, total team points scored. Additional entry fees will be in force for each team pairing. Team pairings must be from the same day of play.

VIII.- SPRING 2-MAN TRIPLE PLAY

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Format:

Holes 1-6, Best ball Holes 7-12, Scramble Holes 13-18, Chapman

- C. Competition will be Gross & net by division.
- D. Divisions will be determined by number of entries, team handicaps, and ages (for senior events).
- E. Handicap will be ½ team total taken from the gross score. (See Current Handicap Index)
- F. For the scramble: 2 drives & 2 second shots required of each player.
- G. Chapman Format: Both players tee off. Each plays their partners tee shot. The best, next shot is chosen. If player A's shot is chosen, then player B plays next. If player B's shot is chosen, then player A plays next. Alternate shot format is used until the ball is holed out.

IX.- 3-4-5 TOURNAMENT

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play will be low net score of nine holes. Score will be from the best 3 holes each of par 3's, par 4's, & par 5's.
- C. Handicap will be ½ course handicap taken from the gross score. (See Current Handicap Index)
- D. Divisions will be determined by number of entries and ages (for senior events). A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions.

X.- STEAK NIGHT NINE HOLE COMPETITION

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this tournament.
- B. Play will be a nine hole gross and net competition.
- C. Player handicap used will be ½ course handicap index. (See Current Handicap Index)
- D. Divisions will be determined by number of entries. A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions.

X1.- PRESIDENT'S CUP

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall govern play.
- B. Competition will be match play with players using 90% of their current handicap index, strokes where they fall. (See Current Handicap Index)
- C. Current handicap index is defined as the handicap index in effect at the time of each individual match.
- D. Number of entries limited to first 64 to sign up.
- E. All entries will be placed in flight(s) determined by blind draw based on number of entries and handicap index. The past years champion and runner-up will be place in separate flights.
- F. The first round will be completed by the EOD of the start date of the competition. Following rounds to be completed within 2 week intervals. Players failing to compete or show up by their due date will be DQ'd.
- G. At the option of the Tournament Committee, should the number of entries exceed 32, but be less than 50, the first round shall be played on the net medal play basis with the low 32 (and ties) net scores advancing to one flight for match play.
- H. If players are tied after 18 holes of play, they shall continue in "sudden death" play until a winner is determined. Current handicap index differences will continue where strokes fall. (See Procedures for Sudden Death Playoff.)

XII.- CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this tournament.
- B. The Club Championship is a scheduled two day, 36-hole, medal play competition played on specific dates and times. Gross scores shall be used.
- C. Play will be from the blue tees.
- D. If there is a wide difference of handicap indexes in the last flight, net score will be used for that flight. (See Current Handicap Index)
- E. There will be 18-hole medal play each day with the attested scores to be recorded in the Pro Shop. The 36-hole total gross score (except for the last flight which may be net score), in each flight, will determine the winners and runners-up.
- F. Players shall be placed in flights according to their current GHIN indexes (See Current Handicap Index) and the number of entries. A minimum of six players will be used for setting flights.

- G. THE PLAYER WITH THE LOWEST GROSS SCORE FOR THIS TOURNAMENT, REGARDLESS OF FLIGHT, SHALL BE DECLARED THE CLUB CHAMPION.
- H. All others in that flight shall move up the awards ladder.
- I. No player shall be awarded more than one (1) prize.
- J. If ties for first place exist after the final round, a sudden death playoff shall proceed immediately and continue until the contested spots are determined. (See Procedures for Sudden Death Playoff)
- K. The playoff results are to determine a single winner. (See Procedures for Sudden Death Playoff.)

XIII.- SENIOR TOURNAMENTS

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this tournament.
- B. All senior tournaments will be played from the white tees unless specified by the competition of the day.
- C. Players age must be 50 years minimum on beginning day of play.
- D. When applicable by number of entries, there will be three (3) divisions (Age at sign-up deadline shall apply). A minimum of six players will be used for setting divisions:

Senior (ages 50-59 yrs) Super Senior (ages 60-69 yrs) Legends (age 70 and older)

E. Current handicap index prior to the day of play will be used. (See Current Handicap Index) This may be amended by the Tournament Chairman to support timely parings or division assignments of the field.

XIV.- KICK OFF BREAKFAST

- A. These rules and the General Rules shall apply to this competition.
- B. Play is two net scores of team.
- C. Full individual handicaps will be used, strokes where they fall. (See Current Handicap Index)
- D. Four man teams will be by blind draw by the Tournament Committee.
